Docking:

WWBA moorage will be on the Kanaka (Transient Moorage) Dock or on the Breakwater dock.

Call "Westcoast Work Boat Association" on **CDN VHF 72** as you enter Ganges Harbour for docking directions from the Docking Committee

For boats using the Kanaka Dock: 30amp power is generally available

For boats using the Breakwater dock

There is only one 30amp power outlet available
