Membership Qualifications and Guidelines

In order to become a member of the WWBA it will be necessary for you to agree to abide by the guidelines set out as follows.

1. To become a member of the WWBA you will need to be the owner of a workboat, or possess certain workboat related qualifications.
 - A. Definition of a workboat:

Boats that are or were originally workboats with a commercial history or boats that have a genuine workboat design will be accepted.
 - B. Qualifications required to become a member without a workboat:

Individuals that have an interest in and significant experience with or extensive knowledge about commercial work boats but that do not own one may become members.
2. All new applications for membership will be examined by a Membership Committee that will accept or deny membership. If membership is denied, the initial \$30 registration fee will be returned to the applicant.
3. Docking Guidelines: Workboats will be given priority for dockside parking. Non workboats will be asked to park outside of the workboats or may be directed to a different area. These guidelines will be adhered to as much as reasonably possible.
4. Members are requested to call the WWBA docking crew prior to entering the harbour.
5. Payment of dues by applicant constitutes agreement with these guidelines.
6. If membership dues lapse for 2 years or more, the returning member will be considered new and will be required to pay the \$30 joining fee.
