### Membership Qualifications and Guidelines

In order to become a member of the WWBA it will be necessary for you to agree to abide by the guidelines set out as follows.

- 1. To become a member of the WWBA you will need to be the owner of a workboat, or possess certain workboat related qualifications.
  - A. Definition of a workboat:
    - Boats that are or were originally workboats with a commercial history or boats that have a genuine workboat design will be accepted.
  - B. Qualifications required to become a member without a workboat: Individuals that have an interest in and significant experience with or extensive knowledge about commercial work boats but that do not own one may become members.
- 2. All new applications for membership will be examined by a Membership Committee that will accept or deny membership. If membership is denied, the initial \$30 registration fee will be returned to the applicant.
- 3. Docking Guidelines: Workboats will be given priority for dockside parking. Non workboats will be asked to park outside of the workboats or may be directed to a different area. These guidelines will be adhered to as much as reasonably possible.
- 4. Members are requested to call the WWBA docking crew prior to entering the harbour.
- 5. Payment of dues by applicant constitutes agreement with these guidelines.
- 6. If membership dues lapse for 2 years or more, the returning member will be considered new and will be required to pay the \$30 joining fee.
